

## Stabilisation

This can include CYP who are unable to engage due to significant physical or mental ill-health.

CYP will continue to be supported by Kingfisher staff, this may include support with next steps and looking at other provisions where appropriate.

This includes CYP who have Kingfisher/Silverdale named as the provision on their EHCP. Communication is maintained with the Local Authority and EHCP Reviews are arranged accordingly.

Students will be linked in with careers advice and guidance from the IAG team, supported by Kingfisher staff.

We maintain regular communication with parent/ carers of CYP, even when not attending classes at Silverdale.

Additional mentor support to move onto engagement pathway.

It may be appropriate to support CYP with resitting GCSEs or repeating Y11 when on this pathway.

## Learning

CYP who are well enough to engage in the formal curriculum offered by Silverdale School and who are following their chosen A-Level pathway.

Pastoral support is provided by Kingfisher Academy and students access the Hub as per their individual needs.



## Engagement

This can include CYP who are unable to engage in the full formal curriculum offer due to significant physical, mental ill-health and/or anxiety.

Interventions are provided based on individual need, with the aim of reengaging the CYP with their chosen course of study.

The AV1 Robot may be used to attend lessons remotely from the Hub and stay up to date with class content.

## Review

All students have 3 statutory reviews per year, including the EHCP Review.

Other reviews are completed using the extended support plan paperwork, which feeds into students' EHCP Reviews.

Student/parent/carers reviews can also be requested outside, alongside Silverdale parent/carers events, such as Parents' Evening.

Regular meetings between Kingfisher and Silverdale staff take place to share updated IEPs.

Kingfisher may look to work with Silverdale on a bespoke curriculum offer for students where appropriate.

### Please note:

- Students are encouraged to attend classes in the first instance, but are able to attend remotely via the AV1 robot, or stay in the Hub and complete independent study with staff support.
  - Students are able to study up to 4 A-Levels alongside an EPQ qualification, up to 19 years of age.
  - Students will move between each of the stages and this will not always follow a linear model.
- Students will be expected to follow the Silverdale expectations in regards to studying A-Levels, with support provided by Kingfisher staff.
