Stage 1

Develop knowledge of a broad range of careers and the abilities and qualities required for different careers.

Stage 2

Use a variety of sources to ensure that our pupils are aware of the current and local careers market.

Stage 3

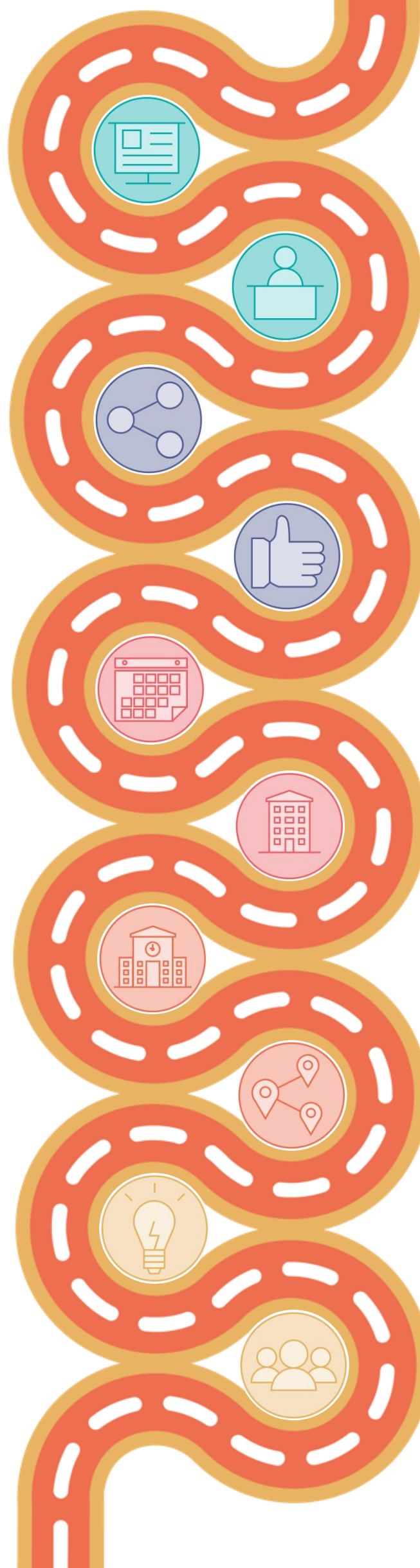
Consider differences in relation to employment, self-employment and voluntary work. Develop understanding in setting aspirational goals for future careers and challenge expectations that limit choices.

Key Events and Experiences

Stage 1

Students are offered encounters with employers and employees. These may take place in a variety of formats to meet individual needs.

Stage 2

Visits to local post 16 providers take place.

Stage 3

All Y11 students are offered a 1:1 Careers interview with a qualified careers advisor.

Stage 4

Students are supported to investigate qualifications required and training routes available for a variety of career opportunities.

Stage 5

Students apply for college places or apprenticeships attend interviews if appropriate and feel confident in their next steps.
